American Heritage with Washington DC

Day One - Travel to Petersburg, VA

Sit back and relax as we travel north on our modern motor coach. During our ride the first day we will learn about the exciting things we will see (L)

Day Two - Mt Vernon / George Washington Museum / USMC Museum / Lighted Monument Tour

This morning we tour Mt Vernon and the new Geo Washington Museum. In the afternoon we visit the new Marine Museum at Quantico. This evening we visit the new **World War II, Vietnam, Korea, and FDR Memorial.** (B, D)

Day Three - Arlington Nat Cemetery / Fort McHenry / Annapolis Naval Academy

We start today with a visit to Arlington National Cemetery. In 1814, Francis Scott Key wrote the Star Spangled Banner while viewing the huge flag flying over Fort McHenry. This afternoon we visit the famous fort before continuing to Annapolis Naval Academy. We overnight in Maryland. (B, D)

Day Four - Philadelphia / Washington's Crossing

This morning we visit historic Philadelphia, including Independence Hall, the Liberty Bell and the new Constitution

Museum. In the afternoon we visit Washington's Crossing, where Geo Washington made his famous crossing of the Delaware. This evening we overnight near Valley Forge. (B, L)

Day Five: Valley Forge / PA Amish Country

Though never the site of battle, Valley Forge played a pivotal role in the Revolutionary War. We will learn the story of the brave men who survived the winter of 1777-8 to become an effective, organize army. This afternoon we visit the Amish Country of Lancaster County, including an Amish style meal. (B, D)

Day Six: Gettysburg / Lexington VA / Robert E Lee Chapel

This morning we visit the new Visitors Center at Gettysburg followed by a 2 hr tour of the battle field. In the afternoon we travel to the beautiful Shenandoah Valley where we visit the final resting place of Gen. Robert E Lee located in beautiful Lexington, VA. (B, D)

Day Seven - Return to points of origin.

We continue our drive home through the beautiful Shenandoah Valley of Virginia and the Yadkin Valley of North Carolina, arriving home late in the afternoon. (B)
